## A shortage of nurses prepared at the baccalaureate level is affecting health care quality and patient outcomes according the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN).

### Industry Demand

LWTech currently offers a Nursing Associate of Applied Science (AAS) and a Nursing Associate of Applied Science Transfer (AAST) degrees. The BSN degree, now required by many employers, will provide a direct degree path to best serve students, and our region's healthcare providers.

### Startup Funding

Private funding is vital to the success of our programs. As Washington state's only public institute of technology, just 35% of LWTech's total operating budget is met with state/public funding. The generosity of individuals and corporations provides LWTech with the ability to bridge the gap between state funding and critical needs that meet industry demand. The startup cost of \$500,000 is what's needed to launch the BSN at LWTech, and is a perfect example of the important role philanthropy can play in meeting the needs of students and industry.
