Students will learn infection control theory and technical skills from classroom lectures, laboratory practice, and hands-on experience in the LWTech Dental Clinic sterilization facility in order to enter into the healthcare industry as a Sterilization Technician.

The **Healthcare Sterilization Technician Certification** is transferable to various disciplines, such as dental assisting, medical assisting, clinics, hospitals, BioTech companies, long-term care facilities, and outpatient surgical centers.

**Possible Career Outcomes:** Sterile Processing Technician, Surgical Technician, Sterilization Technician I and II, Central Services Technician II, Biological Science Laboratory Technician, and Instrument Technician

- Dislocated Worker: Currently unemployed AND either receiving unemployment insurance benefits (UI) or have exhausted UI benefits
- King County Resident
- Able to attend spring quarter classes - April 3rd, 2017 thru June 14th, 2017

- Unlikely to return to your previous occupation

- Need to upgrade skills
