

# Become a Nursing Assistant- Certified in just ONE QUARTER



**Get started in a career in the health field!** Take advantage of the 1- quarter *Nursing Assistant – Certified* program for Spring that begins April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. If eligible, tuition, certification exam fees, books, and any other program fees might be covered.

**Dislocated Workers may qualify for FULL FUNDING for TUITION AND BOOKS for spring quarter.**

## **Eligibility Guidelines:**

- Dislocated Worker: Currently unemployed AND either receiving unemployment insurance benefits (UI) or have exhausted UI benefits
- King County Resident
- Able to attend spring quarter classes - April 3rd, 2017 thru June 14th, 2017

## **And meet one of the following criteria:**

- Unlikely to return to your previous occupation
- Previous occupation is not in demand – [To verify, please visit: <http://bit.ly/KCDemandDeclineList>]
- Need to upgrade skills

## **The Nursing Assistant, Certificate of Completion (11 Credits)**

The Nursing Assistant - Certified (NAC) program is a comprehensive program designed to prepare graduates to pass the NNAAP State Exam and obtain employment in the healthcare industry as competent members of healthcare teams. The Nursing Assistant Program consist of 3 classes (11 credits), taken in succession, over the course of 10 weeks. Certifications include: American Heart Association (AHA) Basic Life Support (BLS) and HIV certifications

### **All courses are taken during spring quarter.**

- Nursing Assistant Theory - NURS 107 (5 credits)
- Nursing Assistant Lab - NURS 108 (3 credits)
- Nursing Assistant Practicum - NURS 109 (3 credits)
